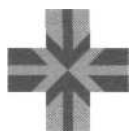

Seeds of Faith has been providing a variety of services and supports to residents of Cross Roads House for several years. Cross Roads House is an emergency and transitional shelter for homeless families and individuals.

Originally a group from a local church, they started working in our soup kitchen, cooking and serving dinners one night a month. They have secured funding for the ingredients, and done all of the work, providing up to 80-90 meals every month. That work has expanded to include making bag lunches on weekends. Their group is among the most reliable that support us, and they have even been willing to take on additional meals some months to help us cover gaps in the schedule.

In the course of that work, they get to know many of our residents, and often support individuals and parents in other ways. Many residents have become involved in their church over the years, and gained the benefits of becoming part of a supportive faith community. They advocate for residents, transport them to various appointments, and provide countless other goods or services that are not available through typical service agency channels. Sometimes this support is provided in conjunction with Case Managers on our staff, but we also know they are supporting residents in ways that we do not see.

They seem to be tireless in their work, particularly their leader Teresa Tozier. They are a stable, dependable, and cheerful group, and we are grateful for their ongoing help at Cross Roads House. Please let me know if I can provide any additional information.
